

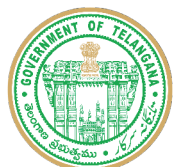

# THE SALIENT FEATURES OF THE CYBERABAD METROPOLITAN COMMISSIONERATE >>>

- ◆ The Cyberabad Commissionerate covers the urban and rural areas of Ranga Reddy, Medchal, Sangha Reddy, and Hyderabad districts.

---

- ◆ It covers a total land area of around 3,644 square kilometres serving a population of approximately 70,00,000 people, which is spread across 26 revenue mandals (495 villages).

---

- ◆ Cyberabad Commissionerate serves multicultural, cosmopolitan areas including vast expanse of rural hinterland.

---

- ◆ The Commissionerate consists of 4 Law & Order Zones, 9 Law & Order Divisions, and 36 Police Stations: 3 Traffic Divisions, 11 Traffic Police Stations, and 3 CCS, WPS, and Cyber Crimes PS.

---

- ◆ There are over 100 marquee IT MNCs and renowned national institutions in the IT Corridor of Gachibowli, Madhapur, Raidurgam, Narsingi, etc. More than 10 lakh employees from across the country reside in the commissionerate.

---

- ◆ Cyberabad Commissionerate is home to 6,200 Large, Medium and Small Companies, as well as Public-Sector Enterprises like HAL and BHEL.

---

- ◆ Shilpakalavedika, Shilparamam, HICC, and HITEX are well known cultural and business hubs.

---

- ◆ Renowned Institutes and training centres, such as, C-DAC, Air Force Academy, the N.I.R.D, N.R.S.C., the TS Police Academy, and the Sardar Vallabh Bhai Patel National Police Academy, are located in the Commissionerate.

---

- ◆ Some of the reputed colleges and universities, such as Hyderabad Central University, Jawaharlal Nehru Technological University, Dr. B.R. Ambedkar Open University, Prof. Jaya Shankar Agriculture University, NALSAR University of Law & BITS Pilani, Moulana Azad National Urdu University, IIIT, and ISB, Symbiosis and ICFAI, are located in the commissionerate area.

- ◆ This Commissionerate has 350 women's hostels, 65 engineering colleges, and 3 medical colleges, making it a true educational hub.

---

- ◆ The Rajiv Gandhi International Airport is located in the Shamshabad Zone. Every day, 400 aircraft carrying around 60,000 passengers and 20,000 vehicles arrive and depart from the airport.

- ◆ Cyberabad commissionerate is home to world-renowned pharmaceutical companies such as Bharat Biotech, Aurobindo, Novartis and Dr. Reddy's Laboratories.

The year 2022 is remarkable for Cyberabad police as many pathbreaking initiatives were initiated. Despite multifold challenges owing to rapid urbanisation and growth in the commissionerate, Cyberabad police has stood up to the challenges and confronted them by providing timely and real time solutions. Be it, TS CoE for Cyber safety, Traffic task force, over hauling of patrolling and surveillance system based on Crime analytics, lake policing, child safety clubs, Integrated command and control, Cyberabad police has led from the front.

Among other things, some of the notable features were an all round reduction of Crime by 12%, whopping 28% reduction in property offences, 16% reduction in UI cases, 8.5% and 20 % reduction in crime against women and SC/ST, 15 % reduction in murders, 19% reduction in road accidents and increase in detection and recovery of property crimes by 15 % and 10% respectively. It is heartening to note that Cyberabad police has always stood first in functional verticals and other crime review parameters for the year 2022. I wholeheartedly thank the entire rank and file for their diligence and hardwork.

Our partner SCSC, had played significant role in many social activities which positively impacted the citizens and Industry. Also obliged to media for their support.

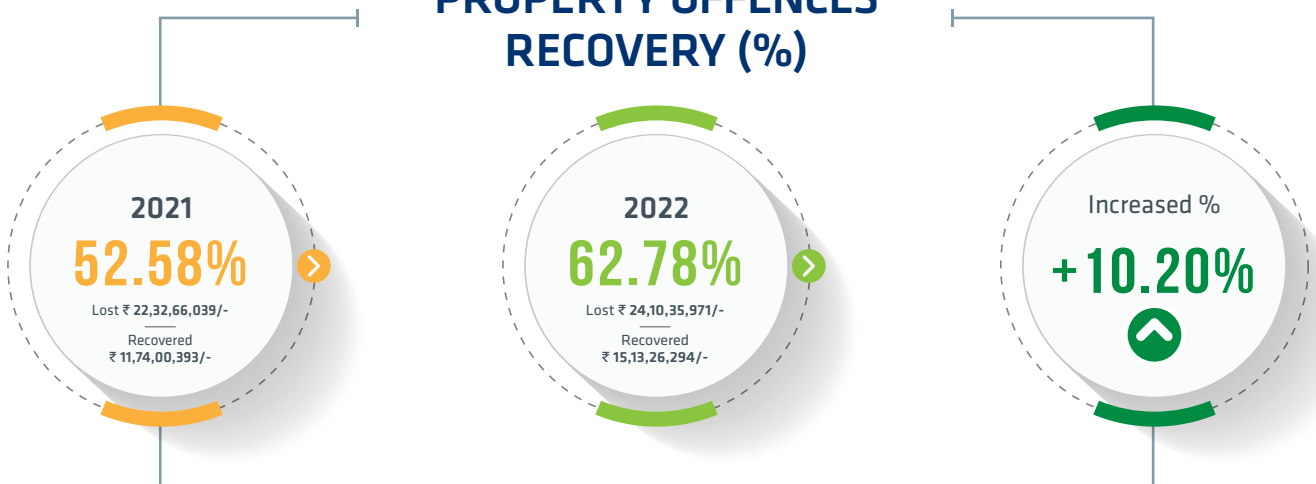
### TOTAL REPORTED PROPERTY OFFENCES

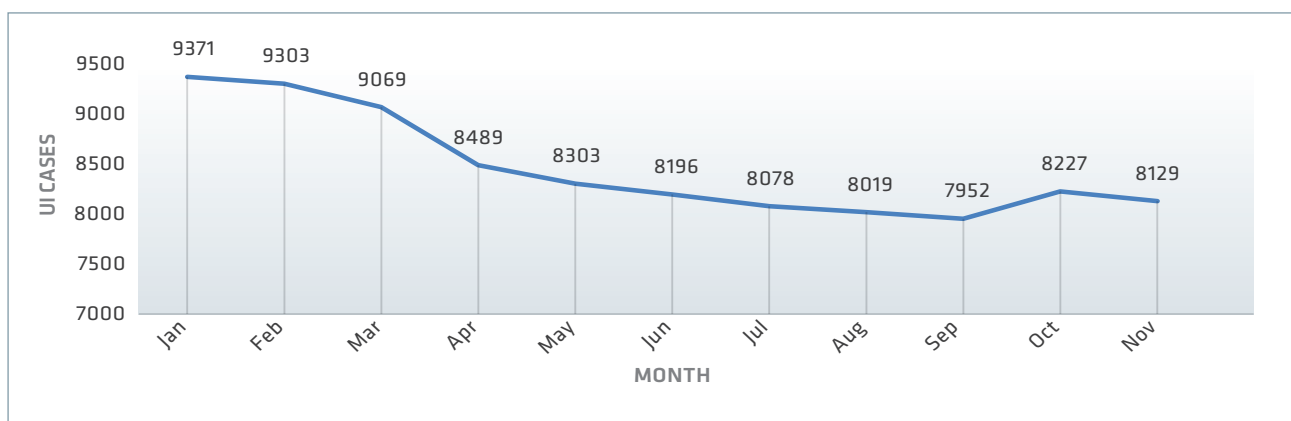

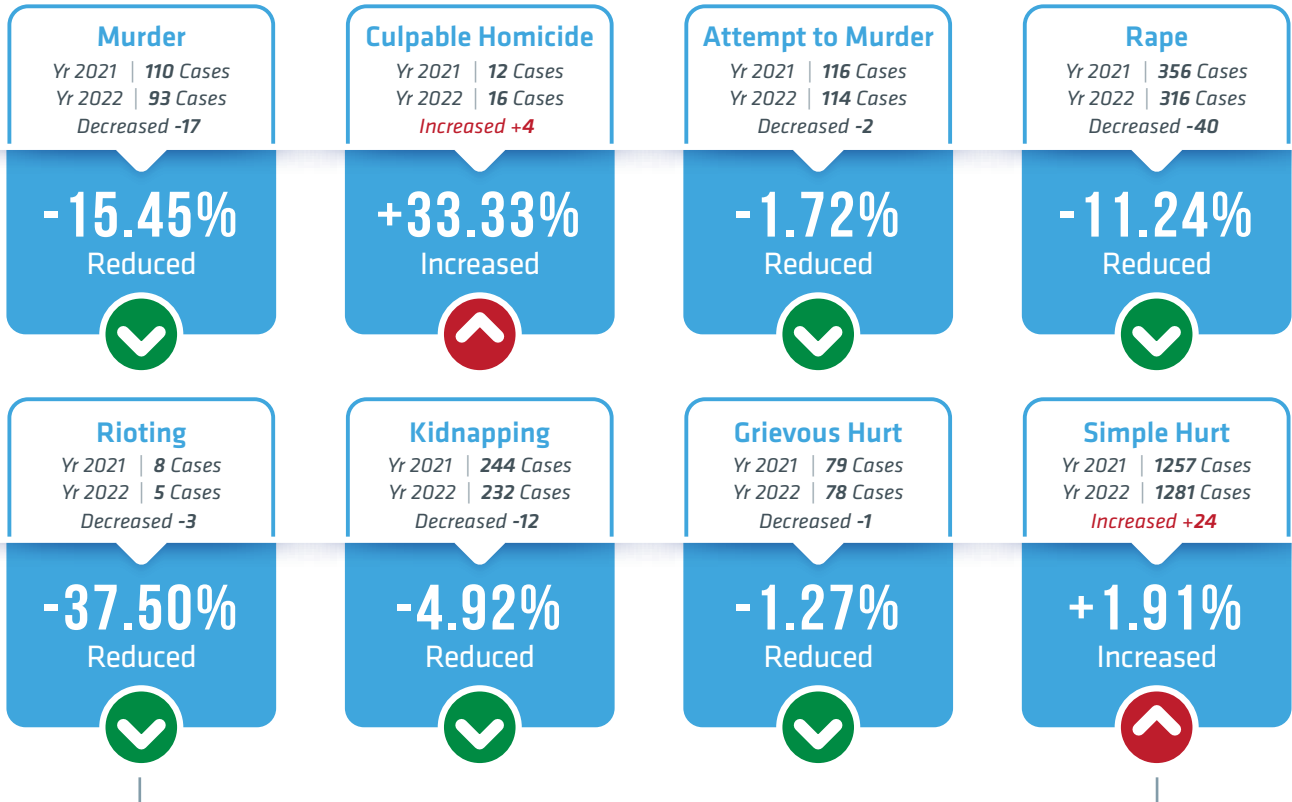

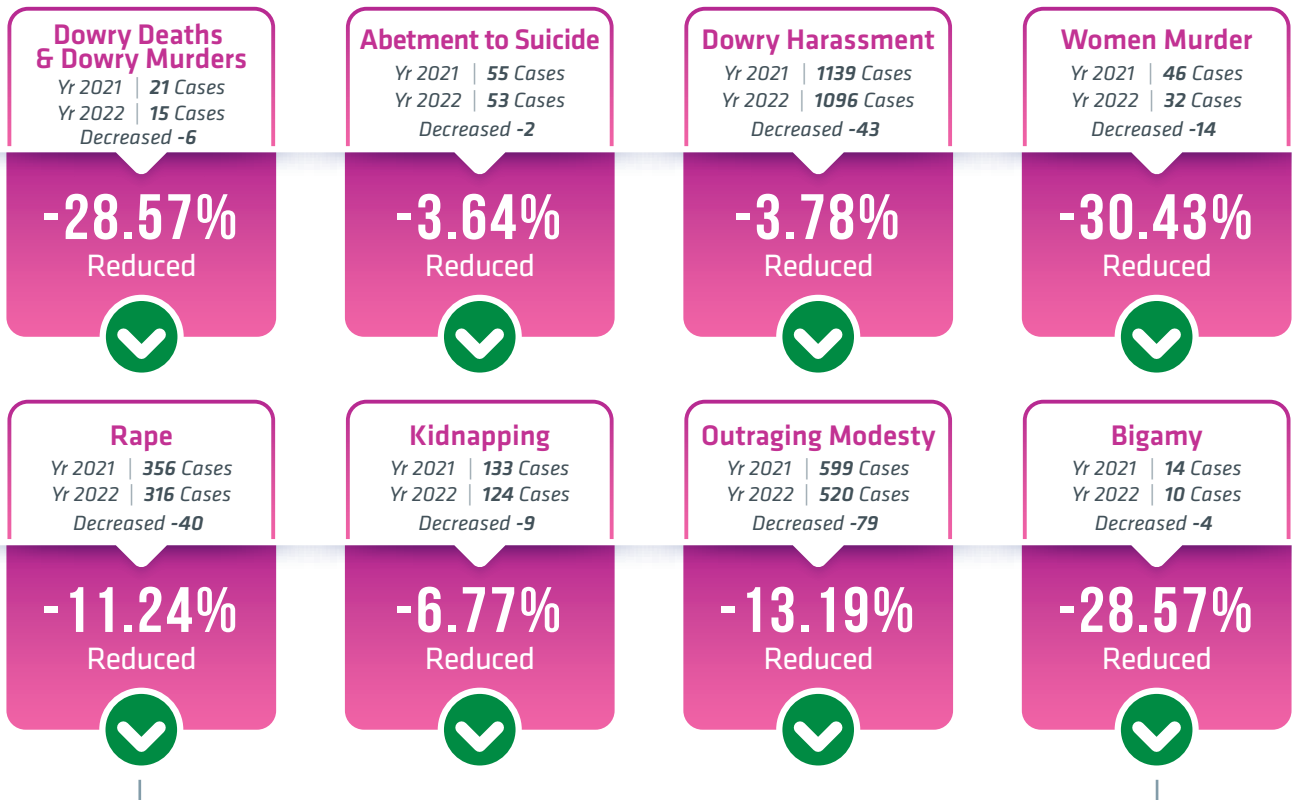
## UNDER INVESTIGATION (UI) PENDENCY CURVE 2022



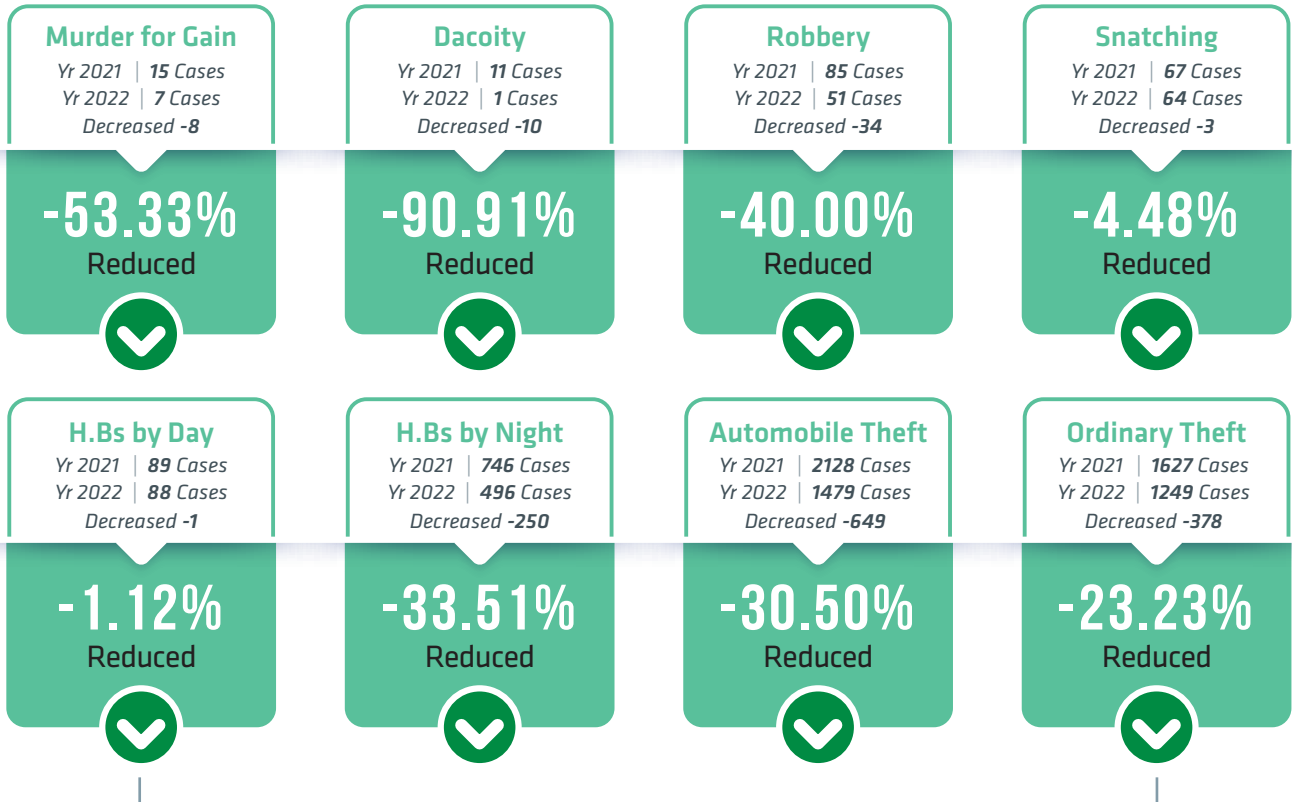

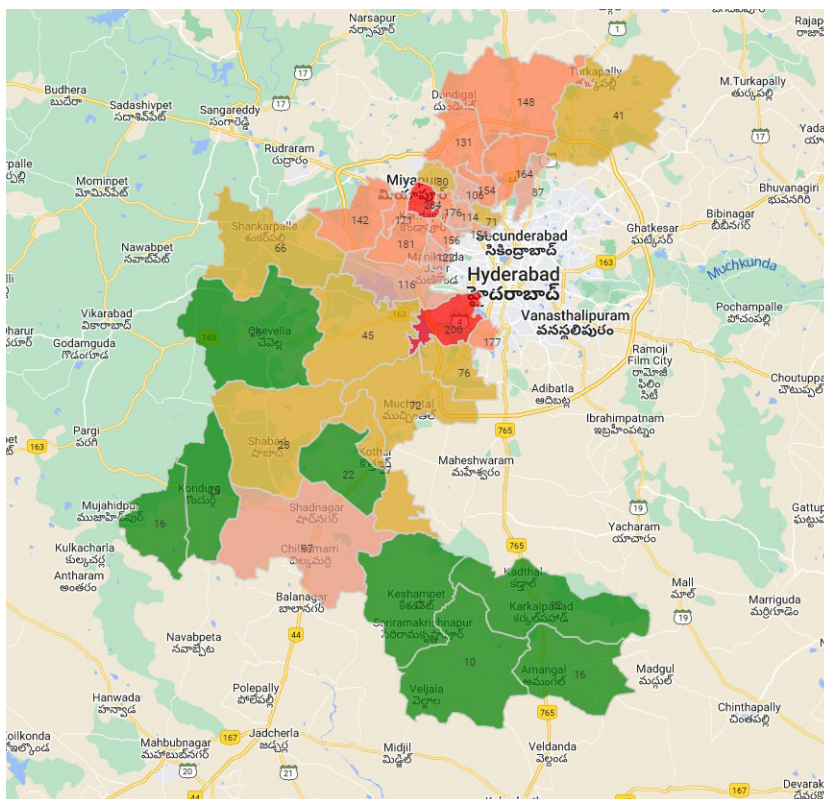

## Functions of Court Monitoring Cell (CMC)

- ◆ Monitor the conduct of trials in courts and assist L&O staff.
- ◆ Special emphasis on sensational, important cases (victims under the age of 12), other important, contested cases, etc., and ensuring convictions.
- ◆ Collection of judgement copies and submission to the PRC (Prosecution Review Committee) for review and issuance of lapse instructions.
- ◆ Preparing for national Lok adalaths and Jail adalaths, setting disposal guidelines PS-wise, and monitoring the same.
- ◆ Monitor CDOs, warrant duty officers, and summons duty officers based on KPIs as per DGP CoE instructions.

Sri M. Mahender Reddy, DGP of TS, visited the Durgam Cheruvu lake on April 2 and inaugurated the first lake police station, which has 10 to 20 patrolling policemen, a patrol boat, and battery-powered bikes, among other amenities. In addition to constructing a watchtower at the lake's shore, 67 CCTV cameras were added for 24-hour surveillance.

3

In a first of its kind of initiative, Commissioner of Cyberabad Police Sri M. Stephen Raveendra, IPS, flagged off six teams of the Traffic Task Force (TTF) that will help in easing traffic movement in the busy corridors of Cyberabad. The vehicles are fixed with a siren and a public address system while the policemen are provided with body worn cameras, breath analyzers, goggles, wireless communication devices, and LED baton, in association with industry and SCSC.

Sri M. Mahendar Reddy, IPS., DGP, TS., inaugurated the 'Bharosa' centre in Medcha, which is a one-stop facility for helping women and children who have been victims of sexual assault and violence. The state of Telangana now has a total of 12 'Bharosa' centres.

Cyberabad police launched a 'defensive tactical training' programme for its personnel. As part of this, eight persons have been honoured as trainers of trainers (ToT), who will in turn train others in the Commissionerate. So far 289 Personnel were trained.

7

Sri M. Stephen Raveendra, IPS., Commissioner of Cyberabad Police, and Sri Viswajit Kampati, IPS., director of Enforcement, Vigilance and Disaster Management (EVDM), inaugurated the Cyberabad Disaster Response Force (CDRF). Along with the National Disaster Response Force and the GHMC's DRF, the force will be a specialised unit trained to provide prompt and effective assistance during man-made and natural catastrophes.

PSIOC provides situational a real-time intelligence. All of Cyberabad's front-line wings, including PCR, SB Control, Analytics, Social Media, the IT Cell, Crime Wing, Traffic Control, Traffic Enforcement Cell and 100 Dial Monitoring operate from PSIOC. The PSIOC Analytical Team sends out daily reports on Crime Abstract, Crime Hotspots, Accident Blackspots, Crime Prone Areas, Crime Sectors, 100 Dial Monitoring, E-Petty Case Analysis, Grave Case Analysis, Point Book, and MO Criminal Checking.



# 08 | TECHNOLOGY INITIATIVES

## Usage of Drones during the Ganesh Festivals, Statue of Equality Inauguration, and other fairs and festivals

Cyberabad police are geared to use drone-based surveillance technology. The drones are used to identify areas of gatherings and processions and manage surveillance. These drones are linked to PSIOC and monitored in real time in order to access routes, gatherings, and surveillance. in real-time live to access the routes, gatherings and surveillance.



## Body-Worn Camera Technology

Body-worn cameras are used during the law enforcement activities involving the public. The video is recorded with time and date stamps and GPS coordinates. These cameras offer real-time video streaming to PSIOC and are used during the Ganesh immersions, religious processions, public meetings and L&O issues.

The real time video streaming, connected to PSIOC, effectively provided surveillance over the suspects and also to access the real time situation to guide the field level police.



## Cameras connected to Local Police Station Viewing Centres (PSVC) and connected to Mini-Command and Control Centre

The CCTV Cameras connected to the local Police Stations command control are used to monitor the security and surveillance. These cameras have also been integrated with the PSIOC.



## First Ever Drone Pilots in Police Department

Two Police Constables from Cyberabad Police were trained as drone pilots and they were issued license to fly surveillance drones. Telangana State Aviation Academy trained the personnel and their services were effectively used during the Ganesh procession and also public programmes.



## Live Vehicle Camera Feeds

The Camera mounted vehicles were used during the Ganesh bandobust and Muchintal bandobust. The Cyberabad Commissionerate has three Camera mounted vehicles for the zones. These were used during the Law and Order issues, mass gatherings, demolition and festival bandobust.

## Established the state of art command controls during Statue of Equality Inauguration and visit of the Hon'ble PM

The entire bandobust was monitored by establishing a Command and Control room with all the stakeholder departments and organisations. The integrated centre at the place of programme helped ensure effective coordination between all the departments involved. The surveillance over the programme was organised through CC cameras, drones, vehicle-mounted cameras, etc.





## CCTV Operation and Management Teams (COMeT)

These teams restored and repaired the community cameras. They also installed CCTV Cameras during the VIP movements. They connect and integrate community cameras to PSIOC.



## Public Safety Integrated Operations Center (PSIOC)



Hon'ble Minister of IT, Industries, MA & UD, Shri KT Rama Rao was apprised about the functioning of Public Safety Integrated Operations Centre. This is a fusion centre of all wings of Cyberabad Commissionerate. All teams work in coordination based on technology, surveillance, and field inputs to assist the L&O Police and Traffic Police in their day-to-day functioning.

## 1. TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT

### Installation of New Traffic Signals

At twenty-four junctions, new traffic signal lights were installed to facilitate traffic flow and enhance road safety. In addition, 19 pelican signals and 1 Blinker were installed to ensure the safety of pedestrians.



### Junction Development

Cyberabad Traffic Police renovated a few intersections to improve traffic flow due to increased traffic and limited roadways. Junction alteration at Khajaguda reduced waiting and travel time for travellers.

### Traffic Management during Major Events and Emergencies

Some of the major events this year included the inauguration of the Statue of Equality, TRS party Plenary meeting, BJP's National conclave, Prime Minister's visit to ICRISAT, Hitex, and ISB, and the Swatantra Bharatha Vajrotsavam celebrations. During the monsoon season, Cyberabad Traffic Police worked tirelessly to ensure free traffic movement without congestion and less inconvenience to citizens.



## 2. INITIATIVES - 2022

### Traffic Task Force Bikes

Cyberabad Traffic Police along with SCSC had launched 16 Traffic Task Force Teams with new motorbikes, electronic gadgets to ease the inter junction traffic movement in busy corridors. These vehicles are fixed with siren and a public address system while the policemen are provided with body-worn cameras, breath analyzers, wireless communication device and LED baton. This initiative was widely appreciated.



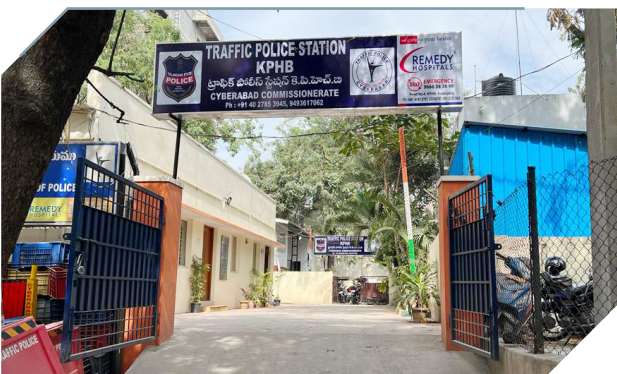
### Engineering & Infrastructure Improvements at Accident Spots

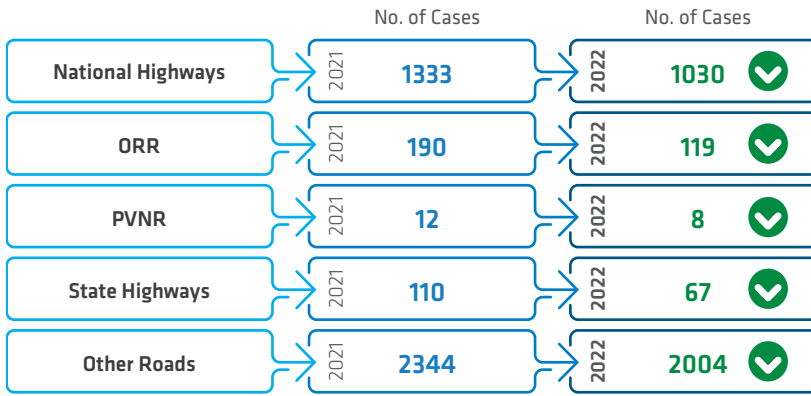
### Trauma Care Centres and Ambulances

## SALIENT FEATURES

- ◆ The Cyberabad Police Commissionerate has specialised 11 units to protect women in public areas, when travelling at the workplace and online.
- ◆ SHE Teams perform decoy operations to apprehend those who harass or tease women in public
- ◆ Conducting awareness campaigns in educational institutions, public areas, offices, buses, and metro trains, etc.
- ◆ Counselling of the respondents by Professional Counselors of Bharosa centre, Cyberabad
- ◆ SHE TEAMS apprehended 1029 persons in day and night decoy operations. Counseled 1209 respondents in 36 sessions. 82 FIRs were filed and the accused were arrested. 1306 petty cases were booked, and 20 child marriages were stopped. Decoy operations were carried out online, and 65 people were arrested.
- ◆ Kala Brindams conduct awareness programmes on Black Magic, Social Media Offences, Anti-Ragging, Drug misuse, Good Touch and Bad Touch, Cybercrimes, Online scams, Eve-Teasing, DIAL: 100, etc.
- ◆ BHAROSA CENTRE for Women & Children supports women and children impacted by abuse in private and public areas, in the family, community, and the workplace. Victims receive psychotherapy as well as relief and rehabilitation. Eight De-addiction programmes and 12 Training Sessions for SCSC Margadarshaks were held at the Bharosa Center
- ◆ Operation Smile and Muskaan are designed to identify missing children, child labour, bonded labour, begging, rag picking, and trafficking children, rescue them, and reunite them with their families. During the year, 1072 Operations were conducted. This is the highest in the country. Rescued 288 children.

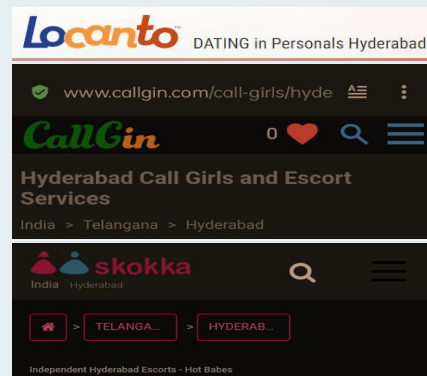

## Bust of Biggest Human Trafficking Network in India

Cyberabad Police's Anti-Human Trafficking Unit (AHTU) arrested 18 persons in 39 cases, including the main organisers and the Radisson Hotel management at Hitec City. The accused trafficked women from other cities and countries using websites and social media. 70% of the prostitution in Cyberabad and Hyderabad was due to the racket. The network lured 14,190 victims into prostitution. The racket was managed from Hyderabad, Delhi, and Mumbai using call centres and WhatsApp groups by 300 organisers from Mumbai, Delhi, Kolkata, Chandigarh, Ahmedabad, Russia, Uzbekistan, and Thailand. The Anti-Human Trafficking Unit (AHTU) and local police conducted the two months operation.

- ◆ The special operations team (SOT) is a specialised enforcement wing in Cyberabad Commissionerate. This wing works on all organised crimes and tracks down the most wanted organised criminals across India.
- ◆ During the year 2022, SOT Cyberabad booked "1439 cases" under various heads by apprehending "3521 persons" and unearthed net cash and total property w/Rs. 39,03,72,460/-
- ◆ 11 gang members were caught for creating fake education certificates.
- ◆ 222 drug suppliers were apprehended, 115 cases were filed, and 40.9 gms of cocaine, 4320 kg of Ganja, 32 LSD papers, 108 gms of MDMA, 58 Ecstasy Pills, 21 gms of Kush cannabis drug, 10 gms of Malan Super Cream, 10 gms of dry hash, 4 litres of marijuana oil, 15 gms of Charas, 170 gms of Opium and 16 vehicles were seized..
- ◆ 1 country-made pistol, 3 tamanchas, 25 live rounds, and 2 magazines were seized and booked Arms Act cases.
- ◆ 202 gaming dens were raided, 1401 people were arrested, and Rs.87,32,368 in cash was recovered, including 19 Matka cases.
- ◆ In 24 cricket betting cases, 70 people were apprehended and Rs. 1,07,25,510/- was seized.
- ◆ 177 Excise Act cases have been booked, 190 accused persons arrested, and net cash of Rs. 41,060 and property worth Rs. 63,23,175 have been seized.



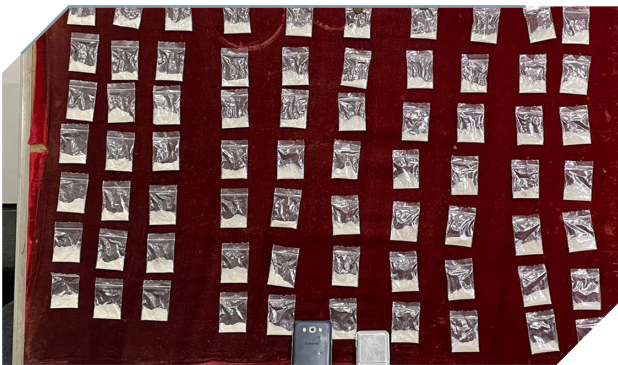

In 2022 CCS detected **559 cases** under various heads by apprehending **224 accused** and recovered property w/Rs. **2,35,30,540/-**

◆ **The Notorious Interstate Chain Snatching Gang:**

The gang was led by Ishan Niranjn Neelamnalli and Rahul. They were caught on July 26, 2022, by detectives from the Cyberabad Police Commissionerate's CCS and Madhapur Zone. The sleuths seized a thamanca containing 13 live rounds of ammunition, a revolver containing two live rounds of ammunition, two mobile phones, a two-wheeler, two knives, and eight Tolas of gold ornaments.

◆ **Notorious HB by Day Offender:**

On September 20, 2022, the CCS Madhapur team apprehended House Burglars Ghanshyam Balveer Singh Ballu and Munigala Shiva Kumar and recovered case properties such as "Gold Ornaments." Approximately 48 Tolas worth Rs. 24,00,000/- were seized.

◆ **Notorious Offender of House Burglaries:**

The CCS Madhapur team apprehended a notorious **House Burglar, Kotipally Chandri**, and recovered gold ornaments weighing approximately 57 tolas and net cash of Rs. 2.70 lakhs. Total value: Rs. 31,28,000/-

On 26.10.2022, the CCS Madhapur team apprehended one habitual diverting attention offender by name Kunchala Shyam @ Gopi @ V. Shyam, who committed theft of (2) attention diversion offences and recovered the case property net cash of Rs. 3,45,000/-

◆ **Dhar Gang, Madhya Pradesh:**

The CCS Balanagar team apprehended the notorious interstate house burglars Dhar Gang (8 Members) and detected 138 cases in Cyberabad Commissionerate.

On September 25, 2022, the CCS Balanagar team apprehended house burglary gang led by accused Begari Venu and recovered the stolen property. This included (510 gms) gold ornaments, (600 gms) silver, net cash of Rs. 1,15,000/-, 3 TVs, 2 autos, with a total worth of Rs. 28,00,000/-.

#### ◆ Notorious Famous HB Offenders

The sleuths of the CCS Balanagar team apprehended the house burglary offenders Mohammed Fayaz, and MD. Juman who committed house burglary offences and also recovered the stolen property (4.5 gms of gold ornaments, 46 thulas of silver ornaments, an 08 smart mobile phone, and a motor cycle.

#### ◆ Nabbed an Interstate Notorious Pawar Gang:

The CCS Shamshabad team apprehended the notorious interstate "PAWAR GANG," consisting of Pundlik Ukala Pawar, Shankar Panduranaga, Vinayak Dharma Rathod, and Balya @ Balaji involved in house breaking by night offences.

#### ◆ Notorious HB by Day Offender:

The CCS Shamshabad team apprehended one notorious house burglar, of Kamepally Srinivas @ Krishna Mohan, and recovered gold ornaments weighing approximately 23 tolas Gold, net cash of Rs. 2,60,000/-, and two laptops.

- ◆ **Preventive Measures:** People are being sensitised through Print, Electronic Media and Social Media, not to believe in any such fraudulent schemes and Shouldn't invest in such type of ponzi schemes. Further, people are regularly cautioned not to think of **'Quick and Easy Money'**
- ◆ **Metalloids Tech Pvt Ltd of Ramachandrapuram PS**  
METTALLOIDS Technologies Pvt. Ltd. persuaded the petitioner, Sri B. Yadagiri Madhav, to invest a huge amount for substantial profits at high interest rates. Jayant Biswas was arrested and remanded on 13-02-2022. The Bank accounts of accused having 8 crores were freezed and intimated to Hon'ble Court.
- ◆ **Blue Life Marketing Pvt Ltd of Chevella PS**  
The "Blue life Marketing Pvt Ltd Company" deceived the complainant, Sri Gajulagudem Srinivas Reddy, to join in a fraudulent chain system (Pyramid Scheme). The director were issued notices, godowns and office space were raided and seized the samples U/C Panchanama.
- ◆ **Super Surfaces India Pvt. Ltd under Madhapur PS**  
The complainant invested Rs. 8 crore in Super Surfaces India Pvt. Ltd. in 2019. Accused Kumar Srinivas caused wrongful harm/loss to the victim. Accused were arrested and remanded to judicial custody on 04.03.2022.

## SALIENT FEATURES

393 cases were registered, 778 accused persons (46 suppliers, 537 peddlers or middlemen, and 195 end users) were apprehended and 15 PD Acts were invoked.

History Sheets were opened against 367 accused persons.

- ◆ In Cyberabad Commissionerate, the distribution of narcotics and psychotropic substances has been significantly reduced due to the police's persistent efforts. Local intelligence networks have been set up to get advance information on drug peddlers and suppliers to eliminate the menace in Cyberabad by registering cases immediately
- ◆ Coordination with drug "Director, Drug Controller, T.S" and joint drive against sale of regulated drugs without prescription in pharmaceutical stores. The DCsP and ACsP held meetings with wholesale and retail pharmacists
- ◆ A "Revised Handbook" on the SOP's for investigation of NDPS Act cases was prepared in May 2022 and distributed to all police stations
- ◆ Awareness campaigns were held offline and online. Kalabrundam programmes were held in villages to highlight the negative effects of Ganja. Twitter, Facebook, and Instagram were used for semi-awareness campaigns
- ◆ Anti-Drug Abuse Committee, were formed at schools and colleges to prevent drug use and stop peer pressure and addictions.
- ◆ Usage of the DOPAMS (Drug Offenders Profiling, Analysis, and Monitoring System) application
- ◆ NDPS material seized in 50 cases of 1410.53 kg of Ganja, 719 ml of Weed Oil, and 11 gm of Cocaine were destroyed by incineration at the Hyderabad Waste Management Project in Dundigal, Medchal-Malkajigiri District, Telangana
- ◆ A total of 32 cases of Ganja weighing 2418.27 kg, 173 gm of cocaine, 1135.09 ml of weed oil, 60.28 grammes of MDMA, and eight Ecstasy pills are under process for destruction.
- ◆ Movable Property seized: 140 Vehicles, 487 Cell Phones, Rs. 8,41,085/- of Cash. Total UI is 214 cases, and PT is 409 cases in the NDPS Act.

## SALIENT FEATURES

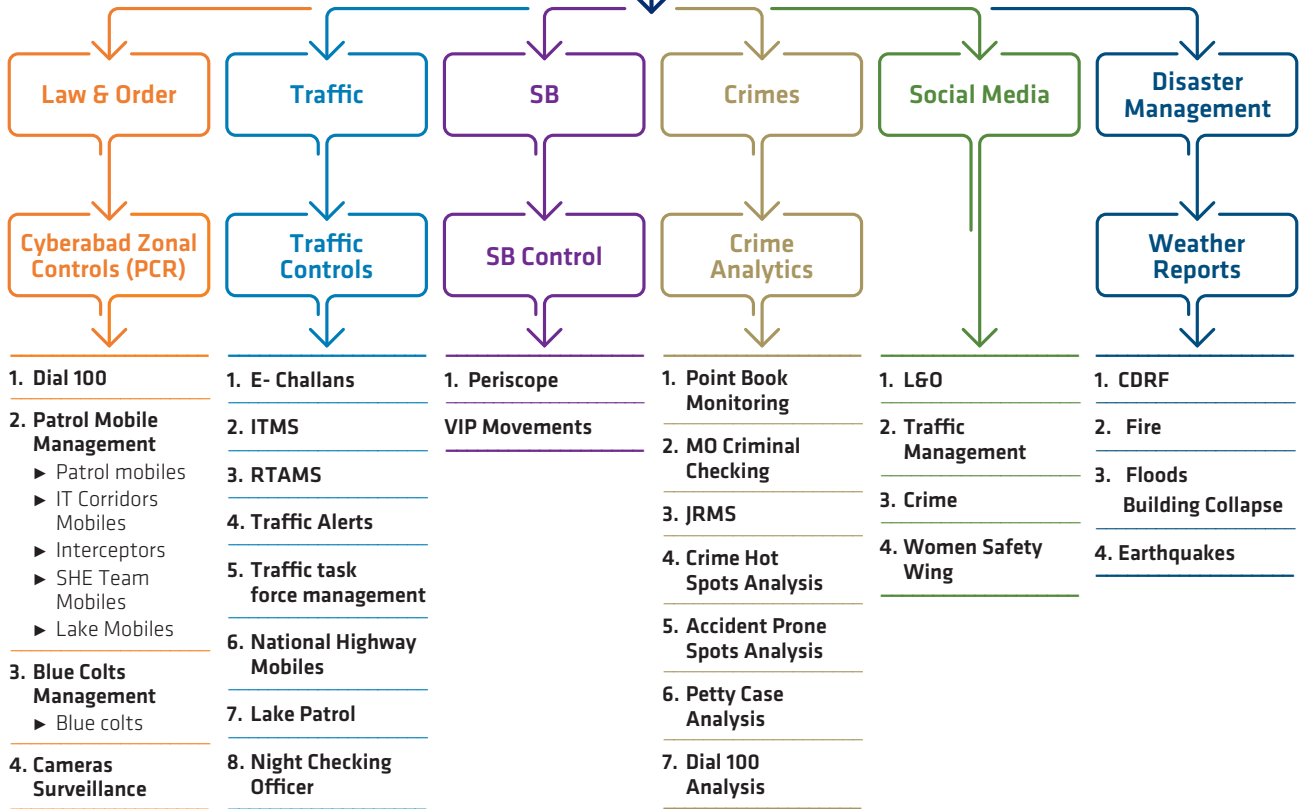
- ◆ This **Public Safety Integrated Operations Center (PSIOC)** aims to provide situational intelligence in real time by combining data from government and community CCTV data sources. and inputs from various wings like SB, Traffic, Crimes, etc. This centre integrates community and Smart City cameras. PSIOC outputs are real-time for field officers
- ◆ All Cyberabad's front-line wings, including the Police Control Room (PCR), SB Control, Analytics, Social Media, IT Cell, Traffic Control, Traffic Enforcement Cell and 100 Dial Monitoring, are functioning from PSIOC.
- ◆ The PSIOC Analytical Team generates two reports daily: one for units and the other for PS on Crime Abstract, Crime Hotspots, Accident Blackspots, Crime Prone Areas, Crime Sectors, 100 Dial Monitoring, E-Petty Case Analysis, Grave Case Analysis, Point Book, and MO Criminal Checking
- ◆ After a comprehensive brainstorming session with BCs, patrol vehicle officers, and crime staff regarding the analysis reports, the SHOs and ACPs will review the PSIOC's reports and send the respective root cause analysis with specific reasons
- ◆ PSIOC integrates 466 Smart City Cameras, 870 Community Cameras, and 149 IT Corridor Cameras.
- ◆ The PSIOC Surveillance team monitors on-screen body-worn cameras (BWC), vehicle monitoring cameras (VMC), and drone cameras and provides feedback to field officers so they can act appropriately
- ◆ The drone cameras are used to keep an eye on large crowds, processions, and dharnas in real time and to help field officers do their jobs well
